2.4 ATA, 90min, 20 trmts *(Must start HBOT within 30 days of an audiogram showing a loss of 30db or more)*

☐ **Carbon Monoxide Poisoning and/or Cyanide Poisoning**

2.8 ATA, 90min, 1 trmt OR 2.8 ATA, 90min, 3 trmts

☐ **Clostridial Myositis and Myonecrosis (Gas Gangrene)**

2.8 ATA, 5hrs 20min, Single treatment

☐ **Decompression Sickness**
